Management Terminal for Windows TM has been designed to be easier-to-use and incorporates enhanced call-logging analysis, making the day-to-day operation quicker and simpler, yet provides a very powerful management tool, enabling you to analyse individual users and team calls ensuring that Access 3000 delivers maximum performance to those who need it.

Simplified Searching

The database management features have been simplified when creating a new user or team record. The Management Terminal now offers you the next available user or team number. You can now enter a user directly into a team, the system tells you what teams are available, and all you have to do is click to make your selection, what could be simpler?

Enhanced Database Records

No longer does the system store pager names and numbers, the system database has been fully enhanced to deliver greater information at a glance. Full user record details, location information, team membership and full details of any call transfers can also be stored.

Improved Wide Area Dial-out Facilities

No longer do you have to make multiple entries in multiple databases to create a new wide-area paging user. Where possible, complex operations have been removed or simplified, making day-to-day system management a great deal easier.

Enhance Call Logging

The call logging facilities of the system have also been enhanced. Using different filters you can analyse multiple call scenarios or lookup detailed information on the call - when it was made, from which device the call was sent and also what type of message was sent. This makes it easier to examine critical events. More importantly the call logger still provides a complete audit trail of all paging activity on the system.

Improved Print Controls

Management Terminal includes improved printing facilities so that you can now select paper orientation and paper sizes for European and US letters. You can also add header and footer text enabling you to enter the name of your organisation and include additional descriptive details. Flexible paging options allow rapid initiation of paging calls - you can page from any of the Management Terminal databases, select the user or team you wish to page and click on the send key. As with all Access 3000 paging systems the team call facility incorporates an emergency override ensuring instant message delivery.

Password Protection

In order to maximise system security the new Management Terminal includes new and improved password features. This will allow access control rights from paging to full database management.

Access 3000 Management Terminal for Windows has been designed for Microsoft Windows versions: 2000 and XP but will also run on Windows 98, ME and NT 4.0

Minimum system requirements are:

- Microsoft Windows 2000 SP2 or later, XP, NT 4.0 SP6 with Microsoft Internet Explorer 5.0 or later, ME or 98 (2nd Edition)
- 500MHz Processor
- 128MB RAM
- 10MB disk space for Management Terminal itself and a further 10MB (or more depending on paging system and archive sizes) for databases and archives.
